Safety instructions slope steps

In general, following applies during transport of the steps, assembly + disassembly:



> Wear work gloves



> Wear safe and sturdy footwear

Assembly



- > During assembly, make sure that the steps are firmly anchored in the ground.
- > In any case, use the steel bar and ensure sufficient overhang on the right and left side



> Do a load test to check that the steps do not give way in the soil.



> When mounting, ensure that the tread surface is horizontal or very slightly inclined towards the slope.



> When standing on the step, make sure that you do not become overweight and tip over to the front.

Weather



> Do not step on the steps during or after rain, wetness, ice or snow.



> When stepping on the steps after rain, wetness, ice or snow, check that the steps do not give way in the ground and that there is good stability.

Use and care

- > The steps serve to improve the accessibility of slopes and embankments. The steps may only be used for this purpose (i.e. for the intended use).
- > Only healthy persons with unrestricted walking ability who are sure of their steps may use the steps.
- > Make sure that the steps are always free of dirt, soil, leaves, twigs and the like. This is the only way to ensure a safe step and a secure footing.
